In brief, students in 5th, 7th, and 9th grades will complete the following tests - Aerobic Capacity (One-Mile Run/Walk Test completed by the family anytime prior to coming to campus), Abdominal Strength and Endurance (Curl-Up), Trunk Extensor Strength and Flexibility (Trunk Lift), Upper Body Strength and Endurance (Push-Up), and Flexibility (Back-Saver Sit and Reach).

COUNSELOR'S CORNER

"Registration to Go" Program for Local Community Colleges

Seniors interested in attending one of our local community colleges after high school should apply with priority registration through the "Registration to Go" Program:

The State Center Community College District (SCCCD) includes Fresno City College, Oakhurst Center, Madera Community College, Clovis Community and Reedley College.

Local Community College "Registration to Go" Instructions

1. Application was available Oct.1st (should now be completed)

Contact me if you have not finished the application.

- **2.** Online Orientation: November/December (should now be completed)
- **3.** Counseling / Advising Session & Student Educational Plan: 4/4/22

Advising on April 4 will take place virtually only (Zoom). There will be three or four sessions that day (times to be determined). As soon as they create the Zoom link, I will share this information with students.

Please Note: Students should not call the community college to schedule individual sessions. Counselors are not available for individual sessions until after Reg-to-Go is completed. The date, April 4, is the designated date for advising students. If a student misses this date, they will have appointments available during Spring Break. Students will need to call and schedule these at 442-8225. They will also have drop in Make-Up sessions during that week. All of these will be virtual on Zoom.

During the Advising Sessions, students will meet with a Counselor in a breakout room to create a Student Education Plan. They will use this plan to schedule their courses online during the early registration dates of April 26, 27, and 28. It is required that all new students attend the advising session before they can register for classes.

4. Register for Classes: April 26, 27, 28 if above steps are completed.
