

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# Familiarizing your student with the online delivery of state testing

#### Why This is Important:

- By having students practice taking the online tests for ELA, Math, and Science, it allows them to become more familiar with the online testing environment, particularly the technology component helps students feel more at ease when they come in for the actual test! (Testing happens here in May).
- Allows students to practice using the accessibility resources that they may be receiving (text-to-speech, masking, color contrast)

# Who takes the Smarter Balanced Tests in Math and ELA?

Students in 3rd-8th and Grade 11

Who takes the Science Tests? Students in 5th and 8th, and once in either 10th, 11th, or 12th

#### There are 2 ways to access the Practice Tests:

- Using the school-issued Chromebook, students click on APPS at bottom of screen when they open their CB's. Then, they select Secure Test Browser and follow the prompt to choose Practice and Training Tests. (students do not need to log-in to their student account)
- Log into https://www.caaspp.org and select Practice and Training Tests.

\*\*Once on the site, students can sign in as a GUEST. No student data collected\*\*

We recommend the Practice Tests because the Training Tests only have about 6 items while the Practice Tests have more opportunities for your student to become familiar with a variety of question types.

**Parents/Guardians:** we will also have hard copies of the scoring guides if you don't want to use the Online Practice Test Scoring Guides.

MHS and GHS will also be offering a testing practice time for students.


### STUDENT STORE

We are offering the ASVAB at Glacier on 3/22/23 from 2:45 - approximately 5:30pm. The test is FREE. Please sign up at the front office by 3/15/23. A one-hour follow-up meeting to help families interpret scores will be held on 4/19/23 at 3:45 PM.

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a multiple choice test used to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. The ASVAB reveals areas of strength and ability in science, math, and language. Students must be in the 10th, 11th or 12th grade (although it is more recommended for 11-12th graders.)
