"Registration to Go" Program for Local **Community Colleges**

Seniors interested in attending one of our local community colleges after high school should apply with priority registration through the "Registration to Go" Program: The State Center Community College District (SCCCD) includes Fresno City College, Oakhurst Center, Madera Community College, Clovis Community and Reedley College.

Local Community College "Registration to Go" Instructions

1. Application was available Oct.1st (should now be completed)

Contact me if you have not finished the application.

2. Online Orientation: November/December (should now be completed)

3. Counseling / Advising Session & Student Educational Plan: 4/4/22 (should now be completed)

4. Register for Classes: April 26, 27, 28 if above steps are completed.

Fall, 2022 Community College classes through the High School Enrichment **Program (HSE)**

This is a fantastic opportunity for next years juniors and seniors!

The High School Enrichment program at the Community College offers students in the 11th, and 12th grades an opportunity to enroll in college courses to receive college credit along with high school credit. Students should be applying now for this Fall, 2022. I recommend having all the paperwork in by the first week of May.

Students admitted to the program are treated as new students each semester attended, and are eligible to register during the open enrollment period. The enrollment period for the Fall session is open now.

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

- The ability to get ahead and earn college credit while still in High School.
- **No tuition costs -** Student is responsible for books and materials required for the course. Upon completion of the course, student may submit to us a final community college transcript and a receipt for books and materials for reimbursement.

To aualify for HSE a student must fulfill thefollowing criteria:

- Have a cumulative high school GPA of at least a 2.5
- Obtain approval (Signatures) from the high school principal, high school counselor or advising teacher, and a parent.
- The student must meet all the necessary prerequisites for any college course in which they wish to enroll.



Fall, 2022 Community College classes through the High School Enrichment Program (HSE)...continued

Application process:

- Complete HSE online college application unless you already have before. (Go to community college website and click apply now.) Student will receive a SCCCD College ID: # 09XXXXX (NOT the CCC Apply ID that begins with a letter).
 - Complete HSE packet with ALL required signatures.
 - Meet with a Community College Center Academic Counselor AFTER completion of HSE packet with principal, high school counselor, and parent signatures.
 - Receive approval of completed HSE packet by Community College Center Academic Counselor (INCOMPLETE packets will be returned to student and they must reschedule).
