WHY THIS IS IMPORTANT:

- By having students practice taking the online tests for ELA, Math, and Science, it allows them to become more familiar with the online testing environment, particularly the technology component!

- 1. Using the school-issued Chromebook, students click on APPS at bottom of screen when they open their CB's. Then, they select Secure Test Browser and follow the prompt to choose Practice and Training Tests. (students do not need to log-in to their student account)
- 2. Log into https://www.caaspp.org and select Practice and Training Tests.

Once on the site, students can sign in as a GUEST. No student data collected

We recommend the Practice Tests because the Training Tests only have about 6 items while the Practice Tests have more opportunities for your student to become familiar with a variety of question types. We also have hard copies of the scoring guides if you don't want to use the Online Practice Test Scoring Guides.
