GHS SENDS STUDENTS TO THE MADERA COUNTY POETRY OUT LOUD COMPETITION

Four GHS students qualified to move on to the Madera County Poetry Out Loud competition which was held at the Madera Arts Council Circle Gallery on February 7, 2024. Annalea Fulce, Noah Mellon, Alexander Roeder, Katie Smith, and their families made the trip down to Madera as did their coach, Mrs. Friesen. Former GHS teacher, Bruce Boe, and current GHS teacher, Lisa Boe, surprised everyone by also attending the event.

Students from Glacier, Yosemite High School, and Voyager High School took turns reciting their two poems while the judges scored the recitations. When all of the recitations had been given and the final scores tabulated, the results were: 1st place and \$1,000 went to Sarah Noah Mellon 3rd place, Sarah Johnson 1st Johnson of YHS. Sarah, who attended MHS before high school,


TECHNOLOGY CORNER



FAFSA and Money Matters


All seniors planning on attending any college or a career technical school:

ASVAB Test: Wednesday, April 2nd, 1:45 PM at Glacier in Mod "C" For 10-12th graders

The ASVAB CEP is a complete career planning program. Students are given the opportunity to take the ASVAB at no cost and no commitment to military service. The ASVAB CEP also provides an interest assessment and planning tools to help young adults explore career field entry requirements and various career paths, both military and civilian. High school students in grades 10, 11 and 12 and those enrolled at post-secondary institutions can participate in the ASVAB

CEP. Students in 11th grade and beyond receive valid scores for enlistment. The ASVAB Interpretation date (this is where a recruiter will go over the scores and career exploration) will be 4/9/24 at 2PM in Mod "C."
